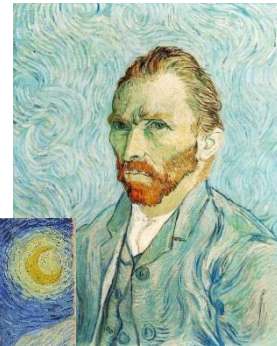

- Making comparisons between countries.



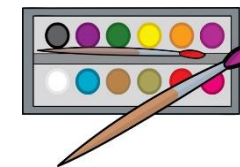
Science – Water Cycle
