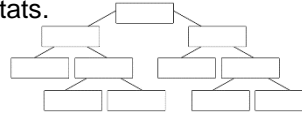
History – Local history study

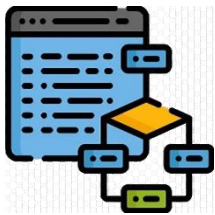

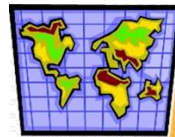
Computing
