To understand and import instructions

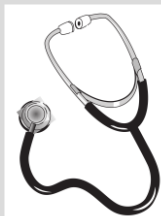
To use coding for controlling objects

Control when drawings appear and set the pen colour, size and shape.

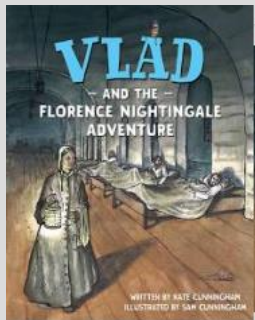
