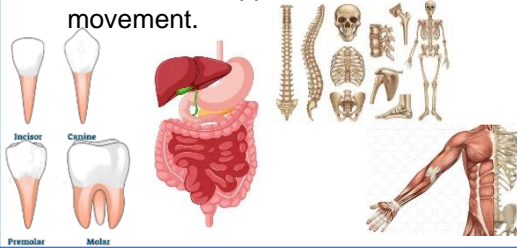
Key Vocabulary

- Identify the role of skeletons and muscles for support, protection, and movement.

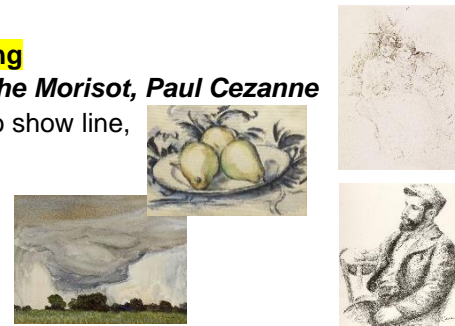

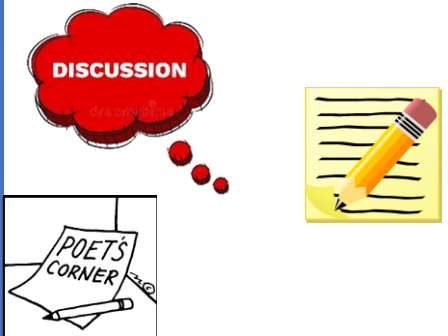
George Clausen, Renoir, Berthe Morisot, Paul Cezanne

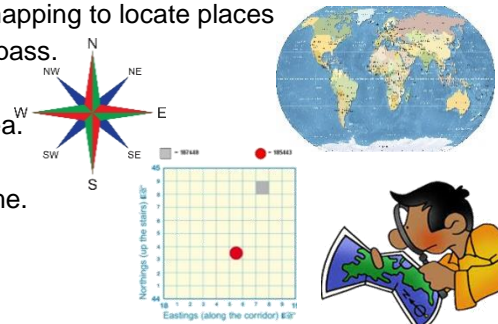
